Computer Forensics

“Computer Forensics” is the art and science of preserving, locating and extracting data from a computer for a specific purpose. The data may be evidence of a crime, it may confirm violation of company policy or it may simply be data which is significant to a particular agency or client for various reasons.

Computers retain much more data than most people realize. There are numerous “hiding places” where data can exist in complete or fragmented form. Using special methods and protocols, this data can be discovered and safely extracted. Proper examination can recover all pertinent data no matter where it currently resides or how it currently exists.

Computer forensic analysis is becoming increasingly useful to business. Computers can contain evidence in many types of human resources proceedings, including sexual harassment suits, allegations of discrimination, wrongful termination claims, and others.

Evidence can be found in electronic mail systems, on network servers and within an individual employee’s computer. However, due to the ease with which computer data can be manipulated, if the search and analysis is not performed by a trained computer forensics specialist, it could be worthless.

All computer forensic examinations are unique in their purpose and the manner in which they are conducted.
